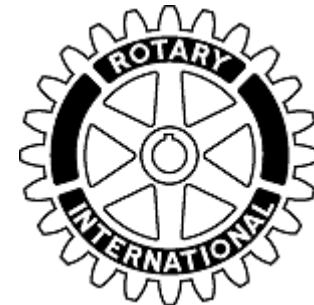

Facts About Owego Rotary Club

- * Founded in 1920

- * Meets weekly for fellowship and programs of local and global interest

- * Committed to making the community a better place to live and work, through numerous projects throughout the year

- * Actively participates in a Youth Exchange Program by sending exchange students from the local area to foreign countries by hosting exchange students from foreign countries

- * Sponsors Interact Clubs (service organizations for high school students)

- * Sends students from area schools to a Rotary 5-day leadership training seminar each summer

Rotary Odds and Ends

- * Membership is based on personal character and vocation, by invitation or by expressing interest in the club and serving others.

- * Members commit to be actively engaged and to participate in meetings and projects.

- * Members are required to maintain a minimum attendance level.

- * Dues are \$128 per year, and can be paid quarterly.

- * An initiation fee of \$25 is required of all new members.

- * Weekly cost of the luncheon meeting is \$6 for salad or \$9 for a full meal.

- * Cost of the optional breakfast meeting varies - ordered from the menu.
